

Civic Tech Hackathon 2019

We would like to invite Hacktivists, social innovators and Civic-Tech experts to our amazing event in Belarus – "Civic Tech Hackathon 2019". In Belarus and Germany, there are many actors working in the field of Civic Tech. So Falanster.by, Wechange.eco and the Kartevonmorgen.org Teams decided to bring those actors from East and West together to learn from each other, to get to know other cultures and ways to look at the topic and of course jointly program together. There will be participating 20 participants from Belarus and 20 from Germany. We pay all the expenses and travel costs so that you do not have to worry about anything. We will stay in a Spa hotel on a river with a swimming pool / sauna and nice outdoor activities in the countryside in Belarus.

During this one week, we will jointly set up a Belarusian version of kartevonmorgen.de and take care of the API to connect Wechange and kartevonmorgen. The main goal here is to provide a first step to a non-monopolised internet infrastructure for Civil Society. The clear goal of the project is advanced training in the field of Civic-Tech. This means that we will provide seminars and workshops on how to work as civil society actors in the field of Civic Tech.

Where: Belarus, in the countryside at the Agrohotel "Krasnoe" http://krasnoe.by/

Who: Hacktivists, Civic-Tech experts, developers, marketing experts, etc. from Germany and Belarus.
